VISITING SCHOOL INFORMATION

Home football games for all teams High School and Middle School are played on the synthetic turf at Mustang Bowl, Northwest 13th Street and Northwest Avenue I. Seating capacity is 8,092. Some Middle School games may be played on the practice field at this site due to scheduling conflicts.

Andrews High School students occupy lower Section D of the west stands.

Middle School students occupy upper Section D. All Andrews Elementary students will be seated in lower Section A. visiting students will occupy Section H of the east stands and visiting fans will occupy Section E, F, and G of the east stands. Student tickets can be purchased for \$2.00 at their home school, \$5.00 if purchased at the gate.

Visiting bands will enter Gate 8 on the east side and occupy Section H. The band gate to the playing field is located in front of Section H. Visiting band and student bus parking is located on the south end of east parking lot near Gate 8.

Visitors will dress in the Visitor's Locker Room in the south east corner of the Performance Center.

The press box is located on top of the west stands and may be reached by entering any west side gate and taking the upper ramp. There is a room in the press box for coaches from the visiting team. Visiting team's sideline telephone booth is located in this room.

Scouts for future games will sit in the stands.

Andrews is a member of District 3AAA which has a policy concerning fans on the field at anytime, during play and half time. We will follow that policy at all home football games and will appreciate the cooperation of the visiting schools.

No groups, students or adults, shall be allowed to form lines through which the football teams pass entering or leaving the field.

PRESS INFORMATION

Broadcasting

Only one hometown radio station and only one visiting team hometown station shall be allowed to broadcast an Andrews football game – either tape or live.

The school shall designate one hometown station for each game.

Local radio stations that do not operate at night may use the local TV cable to broadcast the audio portion only over the cable.

Space in the radio booths is limited, therefore, we ask that stations limit the number of people who come to the press box to the number who are actually working in the booth. If more than two people are needed, please contact the Director of Operations for permission.

Radio stations should make their own arrangements for a broadcast line in the pressbox.

Video

There shall be no conflict within the viewing audience of another high school.

There shall be no promotion or release of intent to telecast prior to the kick-off.

Permission must be granted by the two teams involved.

The University Interscholastic League Broadcast Guidelines must be followed. To be released on the day following the game or after.
